



NOTICE OF DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY MEETING

The Royal Oak Downtown Development Authority will conduct both an informational meeting and regular meeting on **Wednesday, March 24, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.**

COVID-19 is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been previously identified in humans, can spread easily from person to person, and can result in serious illness or death.
