Larceny from a Vehicle, Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property, Driving While License Suspended, Felony and Misdemeanor Warrant Arrest

On Wednesday, February 16, 2022, at approximately 1:30 a.m., officers on routine patrol observed a vehicle pull into a parking lot of a closed business at 4341 Delemere Ct. The officers conducted a traffic stop and the driver's license was suspended and had a felony warrant for Larceny of an Auto for his arrest. The passenger also had a warrant for his arrest.

The officers located two catalytic converters which appeared to be cut off from different vehicles along with reciprocating saws inside the vehicle. A work van was located nearby with a stolen catalytic converter matching the one in their possession.

The driver, 22-year-old Detroit resident was arrested for Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property, Felony Warrant for Larceny from Auto, Driving While License Suspended, and nine Misdemeanor Warrants.

The passenger, 22-year-old Detroit resident was arrested for Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property and Misdemeanor warrant. He was on probation for Flee and Elude and Carrying a Concealed Weapon from Macomb County.

A snow emergency has been declared effective at 3 a.m., Friday, February 18. Enforcement will begin at 9AM that day.

Now that winter is here residents and visitors are reminded of Royal Oak's Snow Emergency Ordinance. Snow Emergency conditions are generally defined as ***a snowfall of four inches or more and will remain in effect until your street has been plowed.*** All vehicles on residential streets are to be removed or will be ticketed or towed. Vehicles are to remain off the streets until plow trucks have gone through the area. Once a snow emergency is called and plowing begins, it takes approximately 24-36 hours to plow all city streets, depending on how much snow has fallen.
