

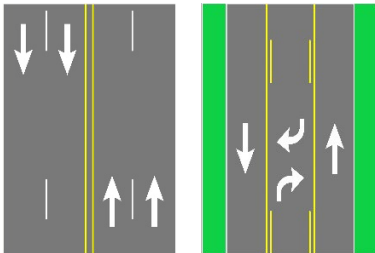
When will this be done?

April through November 2023.

What is being done?

The city will be resurfacing Rochester Road from N. Main Street/Gardenia to 13 Mile Road, including:

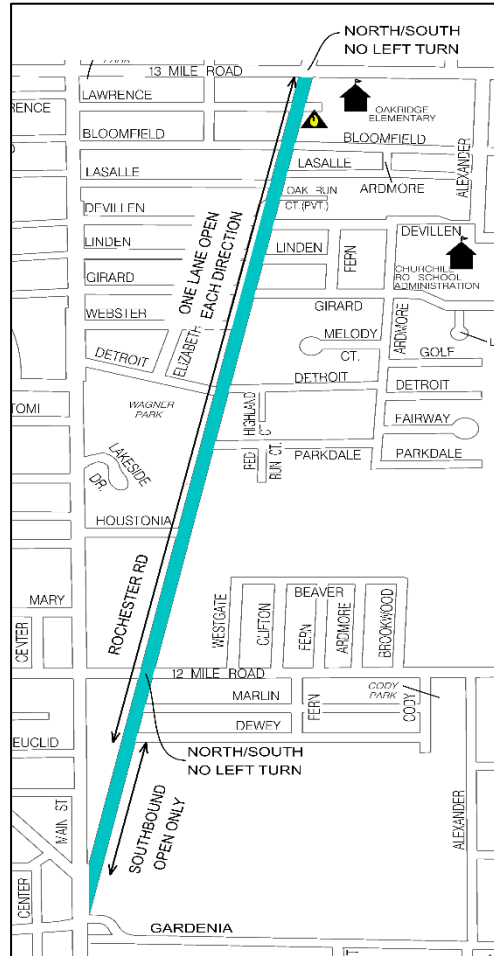
- Installing new water main from Dewey Street to 12 Mile Road
- Replacing curbing, driveway approaches and sidewalk ramps
- Resurfacing roadway with asphalt
- Two new pedestrian crossing islands
- Rain gardens
- New on-street parking adjacent to Wagner Park
- Striping the roadway as a three-lane road (one lane in each direction with a center turn lane)

How will traffic be affected?

Between N. Main Street and Dewey Street:
Closed to northbound traffic, one southbound lane to remain open.

Between Dewey Street and 13 Mile Road:
One lane will be open for traffic in each direction.

Left turns will be prohibited for northbound and southbound traffic at 12 Mile Road and 13 Mile Road to decrease traffic backups.



Access to businesses will be maintained during construction.
